Brunswick JCC Develops Patient Care Technician Training Program

When the Brunswick Job Corps center in Georgia wanted to develop a Patient Care Technician Training Program, it turned to its own students in electrical, plumbing, and painting trades to renovate an old classroom, which they transformed into replicas of a hospital emergency room and a patient's room. It's estimated that this saved Job Corps about \$50,000 while providing real work experience for their construction students. Those studying to become nurses and home health aides at the center's unique facilities receive additional certifications and are more attractive to local employers such as long-term care facilities. In PY 2011, Job Corps graduated over 9,600 students in 21 health care training programs including Paramedics, Radiation Therapy, Dental Assistant and Pharmacy Technician.
